A 19-year-old patient, suffering from severe spinal deformity and breathing difficulties, was informed by other doctors that surgery was not possible and that living with the current condition would be necessary. After detailed examinations conducted by our Spinal Surgery Clinic, scoliosis surgery was performed using the osteotomy method. The surgery was successfully completed and the patient was discharged within a week, returning to the home country on the 15th day after the procedure. This case marked a life changing and hopeful step forward for the patient.
